THE following Act of Parliament, paffed in the prefent Seffions, and which takes Place on the First of June next, is printed for the Information of the Merchants of Great Britain and Ireland trading to North America; viz.

An $A .7$ to difcontinue, in fuch Mamer and for fuch Time as are therein mentioned, the landing and difcbarging, lading or ßipping, of Goods, Wares, and Merchandife, at the Town, and witbin the Harbour, of Bcflon, in the Province of Maffacbufel's Bay, in North America.

WHEREAS dangerous Commotions and Infurrections have been fomented and raifed in the Town of Bofton, in the Province of Maffachufet's Bay, in New England, by divers ill-affected Perfons, to the Subverfion of His Miajelty's Government, and to the utter Defruction of the publick ?eace; and good Order of the faid Town ; in which Commotions and Infurrections certain valuable Cargoes of Teas, being the Property of the Eaft India Company, and on Buad certain Veffels lying within the Bay or Harbour of Bolton, were feized and deftroyed: And whereas, in the prefent Condition of the faid Town and Harbour, the Commerce of His Majefty's Subjects cannot be fafely carried or there, nor the Cuftoms payable to His Majefty duly collected; and it is therefore expedient that the Officers of His Majefty's Caftoms fhould be forthwith removed from he faid Town: May it pleafe your Majefty that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the K1.lg's molt Excellent Majefty, by and with the Advice and Confent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this prefent Parliament affembled, and by the Authority of the fame, That from and after the Firf Day of June, One thoufand feven hundred and feventy-four, it thall not be lawful for any Perfon or Perfons wharfoever to lade or put, or caufe or procure to be laden or put, off or from any Quay, Wharf, or ath $r$ Place, within the faid Town of Boiton, or in or upon a:y Fart of the Shore of the Bay, commonly called the 5 arbour of Bofton, between 2 ertatn . jeadland or Point called Nahant Point, or the Ealtern Side $\cdot f$ the Entrance into the faid Biy, and a cert in other Headland or Point called Alderton Yornt, $\mathrm{c}_{1}$ the Wieftern, Side of the En trance into the faid Bay, or in or upon any Ihand, Creek, Landing-Piace, Bank, or other. Place, within the taid Bay or Headlands, into =ny Ship, Wellel, Lighter, Buat, or Botom, any Goods, Wares, or Merchandife whatfoever, to be tranfported or carried into any other Country, Province, or Place whatfoever, or into ary other Fart of the faid Province of the Maffachufet's Bay, in New england; or to take up, difcharge, or lay on land, or caufe or procure to be taken up, difcharged, or laid on land, within the faid Town, or in or upon any of the Places aforefaid, ont of
any Boat, Lighter, Ship, Vefel, or Bottom, any Goods, : Warcs, or Merchandife whatfoever, to be brought: from any other Cotntry, Province, or Place, of any other Part of ste fayd Province of. the Maffachurfet's Bay in New England, upon Pring of the Forfeiture of the fard Goods, Wares', and Merchandife, and of the Taid Boat, Lightr, Ship; Veffel, or other Bopom into which the fame fhall be put, or aut of which the Täne hatl be taken, and of the Guns. Ammunition, Iagkle; Furniture; and Stores, in or belonging to the fame: And if any fuch Goods, Wares, or Merchandife, fhall, within the faid Town, or in any the Places aforefaid, be laden or taken in from the Shere into any Barge, Hoy, Lighter, Wherry, or Boat, to be carried on Board any Ship or Yeffel outward-bound to any other Country or Province, or other Part of the faid Province of the Maflachufet's Bay in New England, or be laden or taken into fuch Barge, Hoy, Lighter, Wherry, or Boat, fróm or out of any Ship or Veffel coming in and arriving from any other. Country or Province, or other Patt of the faid-Province of the Malfachufet's Bay in New England, fugh Barge, Hoy, Highter, Wherry," or Boaty thall ibe forfeited and lott.
And be it further enated by the Anthority aforefaid, 'That if any' Wharfinger, or Keeper of any Wharf; Crane, or Quay, or their Servants, or any of them, thall take up or land, or knowingly fuffer to be taken up or landed, opr. Thall thip off, or fuffer to be waterborne, at or from any of their faid Wharfs, Cranes, or Quays, any fuch Goods, Wares; or Merchandife; $\mathrm{in}_{;}$every fuch. Cafe, all and every fuch Wharfinger, and Keeper of füch Wharf, Crane, or Quay; and every Perfon whatever who fhall be affiting, or ctherwie concerned in the fhipping or in the loading or puting on bpard any Boat, or other Veffel, for that Purpofe, of in the upfhipping fuch Goods, Wares, and Merchandife; or to whote Hands the fame fhall knowingly come after the loading, Mipping, or unfhipping thereof; thall forteit and lore Treble the Value thereof, 'to be compurediat the higheft Price withen fuch Sort of Goods, :Wares, and Merciancife, thall bear at the Place: where fuch Offerice fhall be commited, at the Time when the fame hall be fo committed; together with the Vexiels and Bcats, and all the Horfes; Catte, and Carriages, whatioever inade ufe of in the flipping, unisipping, latuing, removing, Carriage, or Conveyance of any of the aforefais Goods, Wares, and Mei chandife.
And be it further enacted by the Authority faid. That if any Ship or Veffe? fall be mont lie at Archor, or be feen hovering within the fuid Bay, defcribed and bounded as aforefaid, or wintit Sine League from the faid Bay fo defribed; or tief faid Yeadlands, or any of the Ifands lying besifeg: or within the fame, it fhall and may be lawfar fof any Admiral, Chief Commander, or Commiflioned. Officer, of His Majelty's Fieet or Ships of War, iod.
